- Be ready for your ride early. Watches and clocks seldom agree, and an error of time may result in a missed bus.

COST REQUIREMENTS

City of Lamar

\$1.00 per boarding stop (within designated City of Lamar area.)

Outlying areas to City of Lamar

\$5.00 Round-trip from Holly, Granada, Bristol, Hartman, or Wiley to City of Lamar and return trip, (includes three boarding stops throughout the designated area of the City of Lamar). Additional boarding stops will be at the regular rate of \$1.00 each, provided scheduling time is available.

Coupons are non expiring and non refundable.

ROUTE SERVICE

PROWERS AREA TRANSIT operates three transit buses that are wheelchair lift-equipped and a passenger van for those **who cannot, or choose not to drive.** The safe operation of vehicles and the safe transportation of passengers is PATS drivers first concern. Please tell the dispatch operator when you make your reservation that you will need wheelchair assistance.

ROUTE BOUNDARIES

This service is operated within the boundaries of Prowers County. Rides are available on a demand response basis. All ride reservations should be made 24 hours in advance. Same day requests will be considered on a space available basis, providing they do not conflict with reservations! Special group services are available at special rates.
