



CHAPTER I

Introduction

The Community Transportation Association of America (CTAA) and the Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission (UVLSRPC), on behalf of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) and Sullivan County, contracted with LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc. to complete a Coordination Implementation and Marketing Plan for Sullivan County. This Technical Memorandum represents the fourth report in a series of five to be completed for the Community Mobility Project (CMP). The contents of this report focus specifically on recommendations for coordinated transportation services in Sullivan County. Information from previous reports, local input, and outreach efforts conducted by members of the CMP were used to develop the proposed service changes.



REPORT CONTENTS

Chapter II summarizes recent outreach efforts completed by the CMP. These included efforts to contact local employers and obtain input as well as local citizen input from the Charlestown area. Chapter III provides the recommendations to be implemented for coordinated transportation services. Recommendations include establishing a consolidated call and dispatch center and new services to meet the needs of Sullivan County residents.

The recommendations will be presented to the CMP for review and comment. Input from the CMP will be used to develop the final implementation plan for coordinated transportation services. Once the final implementation strategies are selected, a detailed marketing program will be developed.
